Auxiliary KDF Magazine Capabilities

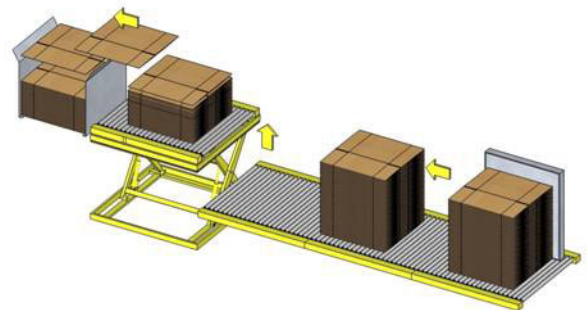
- Eliminate need for operator to load corrugate

- KDF feeder speed up to 22+ cpm
- Accumulates up to 12 KDF stacks for hours of unattended operation
- Rapid change to next corrugate size
- Automatic reject of bottom stack dunnage

Auxiliary KDF Magazine Features and Benefits

The Edson AuxMag can provide hours of unattended case packaging operation by automatically feeding corrugate into the existing casepacker's primary corrugate magazine.

The AuxMag eliminates operator handling and loading of bulky corrugate into the case packer, and provides effective accumulation of the KDF stacks, in a space efficient area.

Forklift loads a KDF stack onto a conveyor. An operator then removes straps & top dunnage. The damaged bottom dunnage is automatically ejected from the Auxiliary Magazine.
